Hardware Installation

1. Turn off the power to your computer.
2. Unplug the power cord and remove your computer's cover.
3. Remove the slot bracket from an available PCI slot.
4. To install the card, carefully align the card's bus connector with the selected PCI slot on the motherboard. Push the board down firmly.
5. Replace the slot bracket's holding screw to secure the card.
6. Replace the computer cover and reconnect the power cord.

Driver Installation

Put the driver CD in your CD-ROM drive. The CD-ROM will start automatically. Click "Install Driver" to start the installation. Follow the instructions on screen to install the driver. After driver installation is complete, you must restart your computer.

To Verify Driver Installation

Click on the **Device Manager** tab in System Properties, which you access from the Windows Control Panel. You should see two **PCI ECP Parallel Port ...** installed under **Ports (COM & LPT)** item.
